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## ABOUT ME

I am a frontend developer with over 11 years of experience creating websites using both pure frontend frameworks and customizing CMS platforms. My professional journey has taken me through Italy and Denmark, where I have developed my skills in web technologies, specifically JavaScript, HTML, and CSS, along with modern libraries and frameworks.

## WORK EXPERIENCE

I am currently employed at Novo Nordisk within the Product Supply department, where I play a key role as Senior Frontend Developer in a planning application known as NNPlanner. This application is utilized across Quality Control, Quality Assurance, and production units within Novo Nordisk. The primary objective of NNPlanner is to effectively manage incoming samples, while also allocating resources such as time, instrumentation, and laboratory technicians for the analysis of these samples.

Key points:

- The application is implemented as a Single Page Application using React, Typescript, and Redux, and it leverages a REST API to fetch and display scheduling data from the planner backend. This data embraces various aspects such as team user availabilities, sample information, and more, which are obtained through integrations with Novo Nordisk databases.
- Session data for the application is stored in the local Redux state, organized in a context-based structured data tree, drawing inspiration from the 'Ducks' Redux code structure.
- Socket.io is integrated into the Redux middleware chain to maintain a socket connection to the planner backend, continuously updating the Redux state with data events.
- Originally built with Create React App and Webpack, the application now leverages Vite to deliver faster development and build times.
- The NNPlanner application consists of two main parts: the schedule, enabling users and planners to interact with their tasks and analyses; and the forms, allowing users to create and set new tasks, availabilities, etc., utilizing react-form-hook and Zod for TypeScript schema and user validation.
- Styling initially utilized CSS-modules, and ongoing efforts are focused on upgrading them to use the Tailwind CSS framework.
- Implementing Umami as a tool for collecting analytical data and analysing user behaviour to gain insights into performance and usage trends.
- Contributed to backend development in Python, including exposing additional fields from API responses.

I've been part of the Content Delivery team inside the CET Tribe in DFDS. We, as a team, were in charge of platform tasks and content creation for the B2B department. In particular, our team was responsible for the creation of content-models and maintenance of features hosted in Contentful that are part of the common navigation, forms, and components belonging to the pages inside the freight-ferries-and-logistics section as well as the migration of its content.

- Use of tools such as Typescript, React, Nextjs as well as experience with fetching data from Contentful with GraphQL and Rest calls.
- Development of the flows for the deployment of PRs, previews and releases of our application with the use of Vercel and GitHub Actions.
- Configuration and migration of different dependencies in our application as part of monorepo with the use of Turborepo.
- Implementation of the new design library Hydro 2 with the use of the headless library component ReachUI and CSS-in-JS library Stitches.

- Active use of Playwright as an end2end and visual regression testing tool for our application.
- Migration of content between different spaces in Contentful with the use of the contentful migration and management api.
